

What do Bears Eat?

Activity for The Prince and the Witch and the Thief and the Bears

Ideas for Use:

Talk to your pupils about the animals in the story; the bear, the horse and the frog and how they are all different in the way they look and behave. Explore which kinds of food each animal eats and how there are similarities and differences in what they like. Do the pupils like any of these foods? Are there any of the foods they wouldn't eat? How does this compare with their friends. Extension activities might include exploring which is their favourite animal from the story and why? They could also find out more about these animals; what is their habitat like? You could use picture cards or digital images to look at real examples of these animals in the wild.
